REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATIONS AS TO THE OIL TPC CRITERION SPECIFIED BY FSSAI

Sir,

1. Greetings from the National Restaurant Association of India. On the above captioned subject, please refer your Notification F.No Stds/O&F/ Notification (6) / FSSAI-2017 dated 24th October, 2017 (copy enclosed). This notification brings into force with effect from 1st July, 2018 the Food Safety and Standards (Licensing and Registration of Food Businesses) First Amendment Regulations, 2017 that specify an upper limit of 25% as to Total Polar Compounds (TPC) in Vegetable Oil used for cooking. In this regard, we request from FSSAI clarifications on the following points as mentioned in succeeding paras.

2. Clarification As To The Type Of Field Instrument To Be Used In The Restaurants For Measuring Oil TPC.

- a) There are different companies in the market producing field instruments for measurement of the TPC in oil, with different measuring mechanism against the laboratory measuring method (AOAC 982.27).
- b) Clarification is needed to choose the manufacturer of the field Instruments to be used in the restaurants as also directions on the calibration of the instruments.
- c) Further, clarity is also required as to whether the Food Safety Officer (FSO) visiting the restaurant will carry the same measuring instrument or not?
